THE HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN AFGHANISTAN Almost four years since the Taliban takeover of Kabul, more than half the population - 22.9 million people, including 5.7 million women, 12 million children, 0.5 million older people and 3 million people with disability, require humanitarian assistance.

How much money do Afghanistan soldiers make a year?

If we analyze the economic boost that the soldiers have brought to Afghanistan, we may estimate that, on average, the cost of one soldier is roughly \$1.55 million a year, which equates to \$195 billion in revenue for both parties (the international community and Afghanistan) from 2010-2012.

How did Afghanistan's economy perform in FY2024?

The economy showed signs of recovery with growth at 2.3% in FY2024, following 3 consecutive years of economic contraction (Figure 2.14.1). Growth came mainly from a 6.8% rise in private consumption, reflecting higher remittances from the Afghan diaspora and international humanitarian support.
