In 2020, Saudi Arabia completed the 300 megawatt Sakaka plant, the country's first commercial-scale solar power plant and the first project delivered under the National Renewable Energy Program.

According to Christopher Decker, partner in energy and natural resources at Oliver Wyman, India, Middle East and Africa, Saudi Arabia is at the forefront of innovative solar technologies aimed at ...

This compares to a global solar power installation of 100 GW in 2017 and a total installed capacity of 77 GW in Saudi Arabia in 2016. This project was cancelled in September 2018.

Today, the country has 10.2 gigawatts of operational renewable energy, mostly solar photovoltaic. By the end of 2028, the installed capacity should exceed 40 gigawatts.

Saudi Arabia has pledged to generate half of its electricity from renewable sources by 2030. The race to achieve that goal is now moving faster than anywhere else in the world.
