

How much is the subsidy for the removal of photovoltaic panels

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What is the new tax rebate rate for photovoltaic products?

In a joint statement issued by the Ministry of Finance and the State Taxation Administration, it was revealed that the export tax rebate rate for photovoltaic products, along with batteries and certain non-metallic mineral products, will be reduced from 13% to 9%.

What is the subsidy amount for PV modules recycling?

By referring to the recycling of used electronic products and foreign EOL PV modules recycling, we found that the subsidy ratio is generally 1-3% of the product price. Therefore, the preliminary estimation is that the subsidy amount is 1.5% of the selling price of PV modules, which is about 312 USD/ton.

Does China have a subsidy policy for PV module recycling?

The simulations for scenarios S1~S3 are to explore the evolutions of the recycling system under different subsidy mechanisms (other parameters are the same as the baseline scenario). China has not yet issued a subsidy policy for PV module recycling.
