The 220-megawatt plant in Nouakchott will integrate 160 megawatts of solar photovoltaic capacity, a 60-megawatt wind farm, and a substantial 370-mWh battery energy storage system, all ...

With an investment of \$287 million, the project includes the construction of two renewable energy plants: a solar power plant in Nouakchott and a wind farm in Boulenouar.
