In 2018, a 30% tariff was imposed on all major solar product exporters to the U.S. (U.S. President 2018, U.S. Trade Representative 2019). This tariff declined 5% each year to reach 15% by 2021.

US-manufactured solar panels, which use upstream material from China, might see the largest cost increases given the steeper duty rates and a lack of supply chain outside of China.

The updated reciprocal tariffs effective April 2025 have led to notable price increases for solar panels, inverters, and batteries in the U.S., particularly for products imported from Asia.
