The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announced plans to rescind \$7 billion in grants for bringing solar power to low-income communities.

The U.S. canceled \$13 billion in clean energy subsidies as of September 2025. Large-scale projects like wind, solar, EV infrastructure, and batteries are most affected.

Since President Trump took office, nearly \$19 billion in U.S. wind and solar projects have been canceled as subsidies and federal support were rolled back.
