

Title: Vietnam mobile energy storage project

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"Today"s workshop has demonstrated the tremendous potential of energy storage systems in supporting a just energy transition, while also outlining concrete steps to turn ambition ...

In a significant development, Vietnam Electricity (EVN) has secured approval for its first pilot BESS project with a capacity of 50 MW/50MWh.

It has launched a demonstration project in partnership with Vingroup, installing a VinFast Energy-developed BESS at a resort owned by the Vietnamese conglomerate.

Against this background, this article examines the key drivers underpinning Vietnam"s energy storage market demand and provides an outlook on its future development.
